



## Annex: for illustration, impacts of applying two planned data updates to 2026 to 2027 rates, if no year-to-year protections were applied

### Summary

- The table presented in this annex sets out the illustrative scale of impact of the planned data updates and the proposed incorporation of Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI) data for 3- and 4-year-old formula as outlined in the consultation. These changes are:
  - Updating the Area Cost Adjustment (ACA) used in the 3- and 4-year-old, 2-year-old, and under 2s Early Years National Funding Formulae (EYNFFs) by replacing financial year 2013 to 2014 General Labour Market (GLM) data with the latest available 2026 to 2027 GLM data
  - Updating the IDACI data used in the 2-year-old and under 2s EYNFFs, replacing 2019 IDACI data with 2025 IDACI data
  - Proposal to incorporate IDACI into the additional needs factor of the 3- and 4-year-old EYNFF, aligning this formula with the approach already used in the 2-year-old and under 2s EYNFFs
- The illustrative impacts are shown in bands to give local authorities an indication of the level and direction of changes resulting from the data updates, though in isolation of the impact of any protections we apply during the rate setting process. We are consulting on how we should approach protections and welcome your views on this.
- The bandings have been produced by calculating what 2026 to 2027 rates would have been if we had used the data which is now available in the 2026 to 2027 funding rates publication, before year-to-year protections for that year were applied. The illustrative impact modelling does however assume the £6.20 minimum funding floor remains in place for the 3-and-4-year-old formula.
- Following the outcome of the consultation, hourly funding rates for 2027 to 2028 will be produced, in the usual way, in Autumn 2026. These will reflect further data updates that will become available and will also reflect transitional protection arrangements for 2027 to 2028. As such, this Annex is for illustration only and should not be regarded as the actual levels of change that individual local authorities will see in 2027 to 2028.

Change from published 2026-2027 rate	Explanation
Less than -7.5%	Illustrative hourly funding rate is more than 7.5% lower than published rate.
-5% to -7.5%	Illustrative hourly funding rate is between 5% and 7.5% lower than published rate.
-2.5% to -5%	Illustrative hourly funding rate is between 2.5% and 5% lower than published rate.
0% to -2.5%	Illustrative hourly funding rate is between 0% and 2.5% lower than published rate.
No Change	Illustrative hourly funding rate is the same as published rate.
0% to +2.5%	Illustrative hourly funding rate is between 0% and 2.5% higher than published rate.
+2.5% to +5%	Illustrative hourly funding rate is between 2.5% and 5% higher than published rate.
+5% to +7.5%	Illustrative hourly funding rate is between 5% and 7.5% higher than published rate.
Greater than +7.5%	Illustrative hourly funding rate is more than 7.5% higher than published rate.

**[Note 2]** These percentage bands are grouped to show where the change against the published rate is greater than the lower value of the band, but less than or equal to the upper band. For example, a 5.0% change is classified as “+2.5% to +5%”, whereas a 5.01% change is classified as “+5% to +7.5%”

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
