

# Privacy Notice for the changes to Social Work England's regulatory framework consultation

### Who we are

This work is being carried out by the Department for Education (DfE). For the purpose of data protection legislation, the DfE is the data controller for the personal data processed as part of the changes to Social Work England's regulatory framework consultation.

### How we will use your information

We receive your personal data, if you choose to share it, on CitizenSpace or by post, if you choose to complete your response offline.

The aim for this consultation is to seek views on proposed changes to Social Work England's regulatory framework.

The consultation will inform Government decision making on changes to the Social Workers Regulations 2018 due to be introduced later this year.

## The nature of your personal data we will be using

## Why our use of your personal data is lawful

In order for our use of your personal data to be lawful, we need to meet one (or more) conditions in the data protection legislation. For the purpose of this project, the relevant condition is:

• Article 6(1)(e) UK GDPR, to perform a public task as part of our function as a department.

## Who we will make your personal data available to

We will not share your personal data with anyone or organisations outside of DfE.

## How long we will keep your personal data

The Department for Education will keep your personal data as part of this consultation for up to 12 months following closure of the consultation. This period will allow us to analyse the data and publish the Government response. After this period, it will be deleted in accordance with departmental policy
